Panov Alexander Nikolaevich

Born in Moscow in 1944. Having graduated from Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO) in 1968, he entered the USSR Ministry for Foreign Affairs, wherefrom that very year had got an assignment to the USSR Embassy in Japan and served there until 1971. Then, during the following 6 years, he was an assistant professor at MGIMO. Later he worked at the USSR Mission to the UN in New York, was a director of the USSR MFA department, counselor of the USSR Embassy in Japan. In 1992-93 he was a Russian Ambassador to the Republic of Korea. From December 1993 – a deputy minister for foreign affairs of the Russian Federation in charge of the relations with Asia-Pacific Region and Central Asia Countries. From 1996 to 2003 – Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Russian Federation to Japan. From 2004 to 2006 – Russian Ambassador to the Kingdom of Norway. Currently – the rector of the Diplomatic Academy of the MFA of the Russian Federation.

Author of many scientific works and monographs dedicated to the issues of Asia-Pacific Region. Doctor of Political Sciences, Professor. Married, has a daughter.
